# FAQ's – Ipad 1:1

## **How are the costs for the iPad covered?**

- The school currently includes the cost of the iPad's as part of the school fees

## **What apps will my child be using?**

- School Managed Devices (No Messaging or Social Media Apps)
- Showbie, Google Classroom, Padlet, Skitch, Book Creator, Stop Animation, Docs, Slides, Sheets, Socrative, Comic Life, iMovie...
- Subject specific, educational

## **Will my child still need to write by hand?**

- Handwriting is still a very important element of learning at Dulwich Prep. Exams are hand written and boys are required to develop and use these skills.
- The iPads will not be used in all lessons and not all the time. They will only be used if they add value to learning.

## **What systems and procedures does the School have for ensuring my child is using their iPad safely in school?**

- The software that we use to manage the devices puts the same profile on all of them. (can be monitored in school only)
- The Apps that we deploy are checked and screened and are age appropriate as per Apple's limitations.
- It is not possible for pupils to add any Apps to their school iPad.



## **Should we put limits on the use of iPads at home? (We recommend)**

- the iPad is only used in family spaces
- the iPad is used for a set period of time and then put away after Prep
- Boys do not use their iPads for at least one hour before bedtime
- the device is not kept in your child's bedroom overnight

## What can I do to keep them safe at home?

- You should contact your Internet Service Provider (ie. Sky, Virgin, BT, Talk Talk, etc) and ask them what filtering options they offer.
- OurPact and Screentime Apps – will not work on the school iPads
- Please monitor carefully their use of Internet at home

## What are the rules about iPad use in school?

- All boys are made aware of our ***Pupil Responsible Use Policy and iPads for Learning Agreement***, which is available on the school website, the school will use its normal sanctions to help students understand the severity of their actions if they do not follow the policy.
- It is the responsibility of the boy to bring the iPad to school everyday, fully charged.
- iPads are not allowed to be used at morning break or lunchtime, unless instructed by a teacher

## **Key information about iPad deployment, insurance and procedures**

- Boys will be issued an iPad at the start of the academic year, though should not expect to have one on the first day of term.
- The devices are leased by the school and thus remain the property of the school for the duration of the lease. Boys will be told when to return their iPad usually at the end of the lease period (2 years) in the same condition as it was given. This includes the Apple charging cable, plug and case.

## Insurance, Warranty and Claims cont...

- The iPads are covered by insurance for accidental damage and theft (but not loss). If a device is damaged it should be reported to the IT Network Office immediately
- If the device is stolen, it must be reported to the Police within 24 hours and a crime reference number/report obtained. Forced entry or similar evidence must be provided
- Please also note that iPad cases are not insured, but are a prerequisite for the insurance to be valid. All iPads must be kept in the assigned case at all times

## **What happens when my child leaves the school or the iPad becomes old?**

- The lease contract (2 years) requires all iPads to be returned at the appropriate time and in full working order, with an Apple cable and plug (the school will inform the boys in advance). The iPad belongs to the school at all times
- When leaving the school, the iPad must be returned in full working order. Boys are responsible for their own (personal) backup.

## **Keyboards to assist Skills and Strategies for Learning**

- Only the boys who have been identified as needing a keyboard to type, may use an iPad keyboard in lessons. The school's recommended keyboard can be purchased through the school.
